Legend to the EBSQ "Polytrauma Management and Trauma Surgery of the Trunk" Logbook

Candidates for the EBSQ "Polytrauma Management and Trauma Surgery of the Trunk" examination must complete the corresponding logbook(s) fully and accurately.

The EBSQ logbook for this module covers the entire training period and is divided according to the candidate's various training placements.

A separate document must detail the training periods at the different training institutions attended by the candidate. This document must be signed by the responsible trainer for each respective period (see the *EBSQ Training Curriculum*).

For **each** training period (defined as one training institution under one trainer), a **separate logbook** must be completed.

The following details must be included **on each page** of the logbook:

- Candidate's name
- Training period
- Name of the institution
- Name and signature of the responsible trainer

The categories and procedure codes listed in the logbook correspond to those defined in the EBSQ Skills Requirement (Operation Catalogue) document.

The candidate must indicate the number of procedures performed in each category and for each type of procedure.

Each page of the logbook must be signed and dated by both the candidate and the responsible trainer for the respective training period.

The total number of procedures for categories A, B, and C must be recorded in the summary section of the EBSQ "Polytrauma Management and Trauma Surgery of the Trunk" Logbook.
